

TIC's NEW BRANCH IN PHENIX CITY IS NOW OPEN

Facility has been converted to innovative dialogue banking design

May 24, 2010 – Columbus, Ga. – TIC Federal Credit Union's first branch in Alabama is now open. The newly renovated facility is located on Highway 280 in Phenix City in front of Wal-Mart.

TIC purchased the branch from Five Star Credit Union in September of last year. The branch had been closed so that it could be converted to TIC's innovative dialogue banking design. In addition to completely renovating the inside of the facility, the credit union also constructed a three-lane drive-thru with an ATM.

The branch hours are Monday – Friday from 9:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. and on Saturday from 9 a.m. to noon. The drive-thru hours are 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. Monday - Friday and 9 a.m. to noon on Saturday.

The public is invited to drop by anytime during business hours for a cup of Starbuck's coffee and a tour of the branch.

TIC Federal Credit Union was chartered by the Bureau of Federal Credit Unions in March of 1956. The charter was initiated by the civilian employees at Fort Benning. In July 2005, TIC received its community charter, allowing service to members in seven counties in Alabama and Georgia. Anyone who lives, works, worships, volunteers or attends school in the following counties are eligible to join: Muscogee, Chattahoochee, Harris and Marion Counties in Georgia and Lee, Russell, and Macon Counties in Alabama.
