

RECU Announces James K. Adams Scholarship

Retail Employees Credit Union (RECU) recently honored retiring board member, James K. Adams, at its annual meeting. Adams has been a RECU volunteer for over 20 years and has served as the board chairman for 15 years. He received the "Volunteer of the Year" award in 2004, served as secretary of the Atlanta Credit Union Chapter, and participated on the Georgia Credit Union Affiliates (GCUA) education committee. He was a regular attendee at the GCUA annual convention and has completed several volunteer achievement courses over the years.
